- The **Outstanding Unit Award** identifies and honors the PTA units that, when compared to all others in their unique environment and within their own special circumstances, are the most representative examples of a local unit which exemplifies the purposes and mission of PTA.

Early Bird Achievement, Club Awards and the Largest Grandparent Membership

- Deadline for all membership awards are as follows: Early Bird Awards deadline is December 15, 2010 for all other membership awards is March 31, 2011.
- All units must be a "Unit in Good Standing: All forms required must be filled out and submitted by the deadline.
- The Early Bird Achievement – is when your local unit reports 100% membership as of the total number of students reported enrolled in your school on the enrollment date as of October 1st, 2010. (no form to submit)
- 100% Membership Achievement – At least one member for each student enrolled in your school based on the October 1st enrollment figures submitted by March 31, 2011.(no form to submit)
- Club Awards – Presented to each local unit that submits dues for membership totaling 500 or more members, based on the membership total as of March 31, 2011. (no form to submit)
- Largest Units – **Unit by Number of Members, New Unit by Number of Members, Membership Increase by Number, Membership Increase by Percent.**(Two awards are presented – one for schools with an enrollment of up to 500 students and one for schools with an enrollment of over 500 students.) (no form to submit)
- Certificates in Caddo District for units having 100% Faculty and 100% Faculty and Staff.

Outstanding Grandparent Award (Caddo District PTA Award)

- Deadline: March 1, 2011
- Entries may only be submitted by a "unit in good standing" by the time of the program deadline.
- In order to be eligible for this award, the grandparent must be a volunteer in the school.
- The grandparent has a grandchild in the local unit, and/or is an acting grandparent to the students attending this school.
