We must work together to help our students prepare for the Louisiana Educational Assessment Program testing. March and April will be major months for testing in the district. Tests properly used can help teachers guide the instruction of your children, help them learn more efficiently and help you, as a parent, understand your child's progress.

Preparing Your Child for "Success on the Test"

- Take an **active role** in your child's education throughout the school year. Let your child know you are interested in his/her learning by taking part in the entire process.
- Let your child know that **tests are not to be feared** but that they should be treated seriously.
- Be careful **not to overemphasize test results**. Do not give your child the impression

that you are judging his or her worth based on a test score.

- **Encourage** the kinds of **good work habits** that are particularly useful in testing situations: paying careful attention to directions, avoiding careless errors, keeping track of time, using time wisely, and if time allows reviewing one's answers.
- Your child will be under "test stress", **so send him or her to school in a positive frame of mind**.
- Do as much as you can to **make your child feel comfortable**. Try not to say things to make him/her feel more nervous.
- A **good night's sleep** and a **healthy breakfast** will give your child a needed boost.
- **Encourage your children to do their best** reassured no matter the outcome of the test, you will still love them.

Test results can help your children's teachers and principals more accurately chart positive academic paths for them. Thank you, parents, for the role you play in preparing our world class students for high stakes testing.

LOUISIANA'S FIRST LADY SUPRIYA JINDAL VISITS HERNDON MAGNET SCHOOL FIRST-GRADERS TO MAKE PRESENTATION

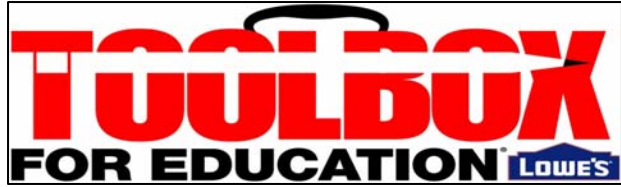
On Wednesday, February 3, 2010 Mrs. Jindal made a award package presentation of four new Promethean interactive whiteboards and accessories to the four first-grade classes at **Herndon Magnet School**. The \$22,000.00 donation of education equipment is part of an effort by the Supriya Jindal Foundation for Louisiana's children to provide more new technology in our schools. The equipment donation was also made possible by contributions from AT&T and Wal-Mart.

Mrs. Brenda McDonald, Principal welcomed Mrs. Jindal to Herndon at the beginning of the presentation. Mrs. Jindal spent over an hour at Herndon during which time she introduced all the Herndon first graders, and our four first grade teachers, Mrs. Andrews, Mrs. Sullivan, Mrs. Miller, and Mrs. Carlisie how to work and teach with the interactive whiteboards and even played Jindal Jeopardy with the students and their teachers. There were also numerous other dignitaries on hand to meet with Mrs. Jindal and to learn about this great new technology.

The Herndon Magnet PTSA Executive Board members provided a light lunch and refreshments for Mrs. Jindal and her entourage during their visit to Herndon, and other dignitaries visiting. It was an exciting day to be a part of the Herndon Magnet family!

Caddo Middle Magnet PTSA was selected to receive a **2009 Lowe's Toolbox for Education grant** in the amount of \$5,000 for the Caddo Middle Magnet Stallion Entry Restoration Project from the Lowe's Charitable and Educational Foundation (LCEF).

In the summer of 2009, the Caddo Parish School Board replaced the existing window air conditioning units with central heat and air units. The new units were placed along the front of the school and surrounded by a 90' chain link fence. Along with all shrubbery being removed, several crepe myrtle trees were removed and not replanted. The chain link fence sits directly along the sidewalk to the school. We have since had a problem with erosion from the fenced area which can result in mud being tracked into the school.

The purpose of this grant is to allow us to install slats in the fencing to camouflage the units, place landscaping fabric and gravel within the fenced area to restrict growth of weeds and use edging to help prevent further erosion. We also hope to be able to replace some shrubs and trees to provide shade and improve the appearance of the school.

This project will be accomplished with assistance from Lowe's and with volunteers from the PTSA and our student body. Our goal is to have the bulk of the project finished prior to the beginning of the 2010-2011 school year.

The Caddo Middle Magnet School PTSA is very grateful for this grant and look forward to working with Lowe's to accomplish this project.

CADDO DISTRICT PTA 2009 - 2010 SCHOLARSHIP

The purpose of the Caddo District PTA scholarship is to assist at least three graduating seniors entering a Louisiana college or university. The amount of \$500.00 shall be set aside for each scholarship offered by the Caddo District PTA. The scholarship is a one time award only. All scholarship award checks will be made payable to Louisiana University or College and submitted for the recipient's 2010 Fall semester. If for any reason the student is unable to enroll in a Louisiana college for the fall semester, the scholarship shall be returned to Caddo District PTA.

Applications will be provided for all public high schools in Caddo District with an organized PTA in "Good Standing". Please check with you PTA President to see if your school is in "Good Standing". Publicity should be given in each school as to the availability for this scholarship. Applications will be available through the senior counselor of the high school.

Applicants must return the application, with:

- a picture or photocopy of a picture,

- and two letters of recommendations
- signed application

The deadline for all applications to be considered
